

## Little TG Ted (crochet)

Size approximately 5 inches / 13cm tall

### Materials

3.5mm crochet hook

Small amounts of DK yarn in red, white, green and a body colour

Scraps of black yarn for features

Large eye sewing needle

Stitch marker

Toy filling

### Abbreviations

Ch = chain

Dc = double crochet

St = stitch

Dc2tog = double crochet 2 together

ss = slip stitch

### Instructions

#### Legs and body

Start with a paw

Row 1: Using body colour ch2. Work 5dc into starting chain (5 st)

Use a stitch marker at the start of each round as work is in continuous rounds

Row 2: 2dc in each stitch (10 st)

Row 3 & 4: 1 dc in each stitch. End with ss into next st and fasten off.

Change to trouser colour and start at any stitch on the paw.

Row 5 to 12 (8 rows): 1dc in each st. End with ss into next st and fasten off.

Work second leg to match but do not fasten off.

Row 13: dc round 10 st of one leg and then the other (20 st)

Row 14 to 19 (5 rows): 1 dc in each st. End with ss into next st and fasten off

Change to jumper colour and start at any stitch,

Row 20 to 25 (5 rows): 1 dc in each st for 5 rows

Row 26: \*dc 2 tg\* rpt to end

Row 27: 1dc in each st. End with ss into next st and fasten off

#### Stuff legs and body

#### Arms

Start with a paw.

Row 1: Using body colour ch2. Work 4dc into starting chain (4 st)

Use a stitch marker at the start of each round as work is in continuous rounds

Row 2: 2dc in each st (8st)

Row 3: Row 3 & 4: 1 dc in each stitch. End with ss into next st and fasten off.

Change to jumper colour

Row 5 to 10 (5 rows): 1dc in each st. End with ss into next st and fasten off.



Make matching arm.  
Stuff and sew to the body

#### Head

Row 1: Using body colour ch2. Work 4dc into starting chain (4 st)  
Use a stitch marker at the start of each round as work is in continuous rounds  
Row 2: 2dc in each st (8st)  
Row3: \*1dc in next st, 2dc in next\* rpt to end (12 st)  
Row 4: \*1dc in next 2 st, 2dc in next\* rpt to end (16 st)  
Row 5 to 9 (5 rows): 1dc in each st  
Row 19: \*1dc into next 2st, dc 2 tg\* rpt to end of row (12 st)  
Row 20: \*1dc into next st, dc 2 tg\* rpt to end of row to end of row (8 st)  
Row 21: dc2 tog to end of row. End with ss into next st and fasten off.

Stuff head but do not close the gap.  
Sew the head to the body and embroider the features.

#### Ears

Row 1: Using head colour ch 2. Work 3 dc into starting ch, ch1  
Row 2: Turn, 2dc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, 2dc in 2<sup>nd</sup> st, 1dc into 3<sup>rd</sup> st. Fasten off.

Make matching ear.  
Sew onto head

#### Scarf

Row 1: Using scarf colour ch 3. Miss 1<sup>st</sup> chain and dc into next 2 st. Ch 1.  
Row 2: \*Turn and ch into next 2 st, Ch1\*  
Repeat \* to\* until the scarf is long enough. Finish  
Sew into place around the neck.

#### Optional

Sew a TG label onto Ted. Labels are available from TGHQ
