

How to make an orange TG rosette for the EAVW campaign

Wearing something orange on 25th of every month shows support for the Soroptomist/TG End Violence Against Women campaign. Why not make an orange EAVW rosette for yourself and then make some others to give to others or use for fundraising?

Materials:

Orange fabric (large enough for 18cm diameter circle) - satin was used in the example

Card circles for front and back of rosette - print out the second page of these instructions on card for these (only one of each is needed for each rosette)

Sewing thread (any colour as it will not be on show) and needle

Scissors (fabric and paper scissors)

Glue of choice - a glue gun was used in the example

Safety pin 2-4cm long

Instructions:



1. Cut out a circle of orange fabric, such as satin, 18cm diameter.



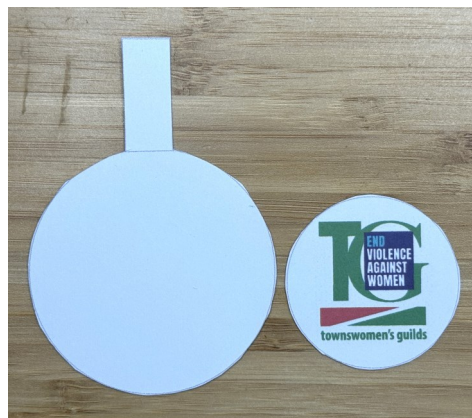
2. Using knotted double thread, work running stitches close to the edge of the circle.



3. Pull up thread to gather fabric and secure in place with a few stitches.



4. Add a few stitches through from the back of the rosette to hold it together.



5. Print out the TG rosette pieces on card and cut out one front and one back piece for each rosette to be made.



6. Fold over the tab on the back piece and slide a safety pin in place - opening part upwards. Glue down the tip of the tab.



7. Glue the circle with the safety pin on the back of the rosette.



8. Making sure it vertical, glue the TG logo in the middle on the front of the rosette.



Wear the rosette on 25th day of each month. If anyone asks about it, remember to mention EAVW and TG.

Make some more and spread the word!
