

Danish Friendship Hearts (recycling greeting cards)

Instructions:

- 1. Print out this sheet onto card and cut out the template below.
- 2. Draw around the template onto a used greetings card picture and cut it out...
- 3. Draw around the template again onto the same greetings card or a plain piece of card and cut it out.
- 4. Weave together the two shapes as shown in the diagrams below. The ends might need a little glue.
- 5. Add a ribbon hanger if desired. Unwanted 'hanging ribbons' cut from garments are useful for this.
- 5. The heart produced can be used as a decoration, book mark, to embellish a new greetings card or to publicise your guild by adding your guild details on a label on the back. These could then be handed out to members to give to their friends, hidden in library books, hung on a display tree in a library or other such venue, or given out at a guild promotions stall.
