

Little Tube TG Ted (crochet)

This Ted does not have separate arms, legs and feet. They are shown by lines of sewing on the Ted when he has been stuffed. These are similar to the way Izzy dolls are made but the pattern is an original TG version

Materials

3.5mm crochet hook

Small amounts of DK yarn in red, white, green and a body colour

Scraps of black yarn for features

Large eye sewing needle

Safety approved toy filling

Abbreviations

Dc = double crochet

To make Ted you can count rows or measure each section, whichever you find easier



Instructions to make the tube

1. Using body colour make a chain of 24 stitches
2. Join the ends to make a circle
3. Dc into first stitch and put the stitch marker in to mark the start of row 1
4. Dc into 23 stitches
5. Dc into next stitch with marker in it
6. Move stitch marker to this new stitch to show the start of the second row
7. Make 4 rows in total or $\frac{3}{4}$ inches
8. Change to trouser colour
9. Make 12 rows or $2 \frac{1}{4}$ inches
10. Change to jumper colour
11. Make 8 rows or $1 \frac{1}{2}$ inches
12. Change to body colour
13. Make 10 rows or 2 inches
14. Sew the ends of thread inside of the tube and trim excess yarn



To make the scarf

1. Make a chain of 36 stitches
2. Turn the chain round and make dc in the second chain from the hook
3. Dc into each stitch to the end of the chain
4. Ch1, turn the chain round and make dc in the second chain from the hook
5. Dc into each stitch to the end of the chain
6. Sew ends into scarf and trim excess yarn

To finish the Ted

1. Push the tube in half and sew across the top of the head to close it
2. Stitch diagonal corners for the ears
3. Stuff Ted
4. Sew across the bottom of the feet to close seam

5. Sew running stitch round the neck with a piece of body colour yarn and tighten it. Finish the sewing, sew in ends and trim any excess yarn
6. Using a running stitch and body colour yarn, sew right through the Ted to mark where the 2 feet are. Sew back where you have just sewn to make the 2 feet show more clearly and tighten the yarn. Finish the sewing, sew in the ends and trim any excess yarn
7. Using a running stitch and trouser colour yarn, sew right through the Ted to mark where the 2 legs are. Sew back where you have just sewn to make the legs show more clearly and tighten the yarn. Finish the sewing, sew in the ends and trim any excess yarn
8. Using a running stitch and jumper colour yarn, sew right through the Ted to mark where the 2 arms are, so that Ted looks as though he has his hands in his pockets. Sew back where you have just sewn to make the arms show more clearly and tighten the yarn. Finish the sewing, sew in the ends and trim any excess yarn
9. Sew the features on Teds face, using black yarn.
10. **Safety!** Please do not use buttons or beads for the eyes as they could be a choking hazard
11. **Safety!** Sew a few stitches through the scarf to the back of Teds neck to keep it in place so that it is not a choking hazard
